DISNEY 5 DAY FREE PASS: Active and Retired U.S. Military, including members of the U.S. Coast Guard and activated members of the complimentary five-day Disney's Armed Forces Salute Ticket. You may also purchase five-day Disney's Armed Forces Salute Companion Tickets for up to five family members and/or friends for \$99 plus tax. These tickets are valid through Dec. 23, 2009. Certain restrictions apply. Military Personnel must present valid U.S. military identification). Activated members of the National Guard or Reservists must also present active duty orders. Visit your local ITT office for details and to obtain tickets.

SPACE A TRAVEL: military-only travel deals, Space-Available travel info, discount travel offers, and more at Military.com's [Travel Center](#)

BILLS OF INTEREST: In spite of a busy week working on economic stimulus packages, legislators found time to introduce several additional bills to assist the military community. **H.R. 775 (Rep. Ortiz, D-TX)** would repeal the requirement to deduct VA survivor benefits from military Survivor Benefit Plan annuities. **H.R. 613 (Rep. Jones, R-NC)** would allow a survivor to keep the entire retired pay for the month in which a servicemember dies. Current practice requires the government to recoup the money and pro-rate it based on the date of death. **H.R. 235 (Rep. Berman, D-CA)** would repeal the Government Pension Offset and Windfall Elimination Provision, which reduce Social Security

annuities for many federal civilian retirees and survivors, as well as thousands of teachers and other state employees. **H.R. 593 (Rep. Smith, D-WA)** would better protect against deduction of VA disability compensation from military disability severance pay in instances of combat- or operations-related disabilities. A narrow interpretation of the recent law change on this topic covers only injuries occurring in a combat zone - excluding those incurred in combat training or other operations-related accidents. **H.R. 593 (Rep. TRICARE PAYMENTS: Beginning in 2010, (TRIWEST) TRICARE Prime beneficiaries who pay enrollment fees will need to make their fee payments via electronic means, according to a spokesperson for TRIWEST. If you are enrolled in TRICARE Prime as a retired servicemember, the family of a retired servicemember, a survivor or an eligible former spouse the electronic payment will be required. These changes mean that those TRICARE enrollees who pay enrollment fees will be required to pay them by one of the following methods: (1) allotment from the sponsor's retired military pay, (2) electronic funds transfer from your financial institution, or recurring credit card. To register and get started, visit the [TriWest website](#).

G/I. BILL: The GI Bill is currently worth up to \$47,000. This amount is based on the 2008-2009 monthly full-time student payment rate of \$1321 multiplied by the 36-month limit. This "payment rate" automatically increases on October first each year. You get the annual increase no matter when you became eligible or begin using it. The term "36 months of benefits" refers to academic months. This means you will have up to 8 semesters (four years) to complete a traditional academic education. Military.com works with hundreds of schools that offer college credit for

Military service.

RATE NURSING HOMES: Spend less money and time in the cThe Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has released quality ratings for each of the nation's 15,800 nursing homes that participate in Medicare or Medicaid. Facilities are assigned star ratings from a low of one star to a high of five stars based on health inspection surveys, staffing information and quality of care measures. The search system allows users to simply input their Zip Code to get star ratings of nursing homes in their area. 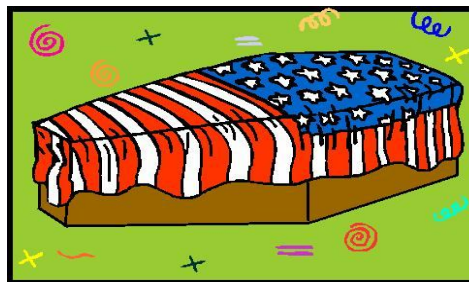
