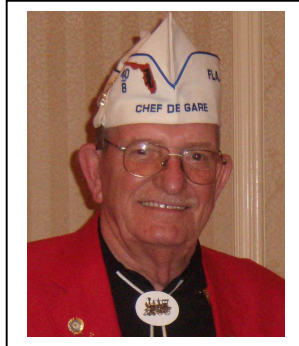

### **AMERICANISM**

I want to commend the folks who ran the Emerald Coast Wreck, Panama City, FL. It was obvious that they put a lot of preparation in it. Cheryl and I really enjoyed ourselves.

“Americanism” What can I report? Is a question that many folks ask, so I have decided to start putting out some information in my monthly articles. Let me start with the first 3 categories as they are listed on the annual report.

**DISCLAIMER** “There are many more examples I have not listed, so do not limit your activities to my examples”.

1. AMERICANISM AWARDS: Schools, ROTC (this includes Junior), Community Organizations (Elks, Moose, other Veterans

Organizations, Masonic, Rotary, etc), Citizens (Hospice, Habitat For Humanity, City and County Governments, etc.), Law & Fire, Other. **NOTE!** *If you participate in anyway with an award ceremony i.e. participant, organizer, recipient, observer, etc, then take credit.*

2. AMERICANISM SPEECHES AND FLAG ACTIVITIES: Flag presentations, raising ceremonies, flag retirement ceremonies, etc. **NOTE!** *If you collect worn flags from your neighbors and take them to the local Veterans Organization for retirement, then take credit. Any activity involving our National Flag (playing of National Anthem at a sporting event, etc) is eligible in this category.*
3. YOUTH ACTIVITIES: Band Support, **all** sports activities (baseball, soccer, football, hockey, horseback ridding, etc) , Boys & Girls State, Oratorical Contests, Scouting, Valley Forge Freedom Foundation, Child ID Programs, Driver Training, FFA, 4H, PTA, Church activities (Sunday School, Youth Groups meetings). **NOTE!** *If you participate in anyway take credit.*

**NOTE!** Just because you may be representing another organization at the time you are involved with one of these activities doesn't mean you can't take credit for your Locale.

Next month I will address the last 4 categories.

I still have 30 Americanism Pins left out of 190 and many of your Locales have not contacted me for them. Come on Voyageurs buy those pins.

Please contact me if I can be of any assistance with your Americanism Programs.

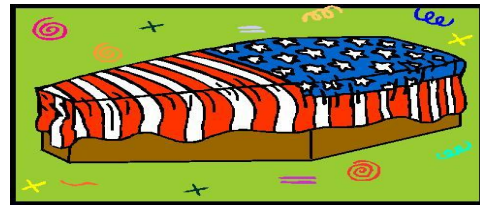
