VAVS

I hope to see you at the Grand next month. Please send in your VAVS reports. We rarely get more than 10 % reporting. How about making a special effort this year to get your reports to me prior to our June Grand Promenade.

VA VET CONTAMINANT EXPOSURE

Officials say more than 3,000 patients at the Miami VA Hospital have been told they should be tested for HIV and other diseases. The VA insists the risk of infection is minimal and only involved tubing on equipment, not any device that actually touched a patient. **No Miami VA patient have been found to have a problem to date.**

Last month, more than 6,000 patients at a clinic in Tennessee were told they may have been exposed to infectious body fluids during colonoscopies. The VA also said 1,800 veterans treated at an ear, nose and throat clinic in Augusta, Ga., were alerted they could have been exposed to an infection due to improper disinfection of an

instrument. HIV has been found in patients from Tennessee VA facilities.

RED MEAT CONSUMPTION:

According to the first large study whether regularly eating beef or pork increases mortality results indicate eating red meat increases the chances of dying prematurely. The study of more than 500,000 middle-aged and elderly Americans found that those who consumed about four ounces of red meat a day (the equivalent of about a small hamburger) were more than 30% more likely to die during the 10 years they were followed, mostly from heart disease and cancer. Sausage, cold cuts and other processed meats also increased the risk. In contrast, routine consumption of fish, chicken, turkey and other poultry decreased the risk of death by a small amount. Death and taxes-- now they are taking away our enjoyment of steaks!

CENSUS BUREAU JOB RECRUITING:

Layoffs may be sweeping the country, but one enterprise is hiring roughly 1.4 million people nationwide at salaries of \$10 to \$25 an hour: the 2010 census. A small army of laborers will be needed to locate, count and categorize each of the nation's residents. This spring, 140,000 workers will verify addresses across the country.

PURPLE HEART FOR PTSD DENIED:

The Pentagon announced that the Purple Heart will not be awarded to troops affected with post traumatic stress disorder (PTSD). PTSD is not a wound intentionally caused by the enemy from an outside force or agent.

SURVIVING SPOUSES DUE

PAYMENTS: Those eligible for retroactive payments - between \$100 and \$2,500 - are the surviving spouses of veterans who died after Dec. 31, 1996. For more information call the Survivors' Call Center at 1-800-749-8387 between 7 a.m.-p.m.,

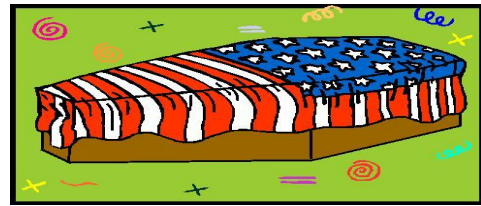
